THE VALUE AND PURPOSE OF OUR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

Our Catholic schools are closing for the summer holidays. We are blessed in our parish to have five Catholic schools: Austin Friars, St Bede's, St Cuthbert's, St John Henry Newman and St Margaret Mary's. We owe a debt of gratitude to those religious sisters and priests who had the vision and energy to found these schools. We owe just as much gratitude to all those who maintain them so well today. Let's say a prayer for the teachers as they begin their well-earned rest!

Circumstances in education, family life and parish have changed significantly since those early foundations, but the mission of the school continues. In the Catholic school, it is not simply that we educate. We educate according to a philosophy and vision drawn from the Gospel and the teachings of the Catholic Church. The Catholic faith is integral to what it is to educate the whole person.

Our school communities, as an essential part of the Church, seek to invite every person involved in the life of the school to encounter Jesus Christ in a very real way. This invitation is motivated by real conviction and done in a consistent and insistent manner. Nonetheless it is a free invitation which seeks a free response. The response will, inevitably, be varied: there will be those who rise to the invitation and embrace it; there will be those who refuse to engage; there will be those who accept some part, small or great, but not all. It is the duty of the school to offer the invitation and do everything it can to enable the fullest possible response while respecting the necessity of freedom. In this sense the faith is both 'caught' and 'taught' in our Catholic schools.
