## CAFOD PETITION - 'SEEDS FOR ALL'

For generations communities throughout the world have saved seed to grow next year's crops, seed that has evolved to be best suited to local conditions.

However, things have changed and 60% of world seed are controlled by three corporations. Their seed provides high yielding crops but requires high levels of expensive fertiliser, insecticides and fungicides and some are even modified to be sterile, so the farmer has to buy more seed the following year.

The major companies are lobbying The World Bank to make it illegal to use noncertified seed in countries to whom the bank lends. It is costly to get seed certified. The laws, which are to be brought in with the support of global financial institutions such as the World Bank, overwhelmingly favour large agri-businesses. Instead of being able to choose their own seeds, small-scale farmers must purchase commercial seeds' something that is good for big business profits but not so good for the small-scale farmers who grow most of the the world's food.

CAFOD are asking you to sign their petition in support of Salina, an organic farmer from Bangladesh who is writing to The World Bank asking them to support the rights of local farmers to use their own locally evolved seed and put an end to policies that will limit their choice and force them to buy expensive seed from global corporations.

We pay larger charges for banking cash and cheques, but significantly less for standing orders and electronic giving. **Would you consider giving your donation by Standing Order** instead of using envelopes or loose cash? If you are a taxpayer and already Gift Aid your donation, we already have your details and simply email [admin@carlislecatholicchurch.org](mailto:admin@carlislecatholicchurch.org) to inform us of the Standing Order. Or you can use the card machine at the back of most of our churches. Those who Gift Aid can also use the card machine: once you have entered your Gift Aid details the first time you use the machine, it remembers your card for future transactions.
