## PRAY FOR THE PEACE OF JERUSALEM (Ps 122,6)

It is extremely distressing to hear the news from Israel and Gaza. We know that this is a conflict which is deeply complex and deep seated. Indeed, we can be tempted to lose all hope that any solution can be found. We can also be seduced into assigning the roles of right and wrong – of good and evil – to one side or the other. We human beings are never that straightforward, and our tensions and divisions can rarely be so easily defined. We turn to God in our sadness and confusion and pray. We pray for everyone concerned; we pray with hearts that are hurting for the suffering of so many; we pray in desperation as we share in the experience of helplessness to make things stop and make things better. This is happening in the very land where God called human beings into a covenant of life and love with Him. This is the place where we were taught by The Prince of Peace, whatever our nationality or the language we speak, to call upon God as Father.
